
**BASIC SUMMARY INFORMATION
ON PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA**

Dear customers,

we present the basic summary information on how and why we process your personal data.

We process your personal data only in such extent that is necessary for provision of our services to you. This principle also applies to processing of your sensitive personal data.

We handle your personal data in such manner to maximally secure them against misuse by third persons.

Who is the controller of your personal data? **Trampoline Investments s.r.o.** with its registered office at Klimentská 1207/10, Nové město, 110 00 Prague 1, registered in the Commercial registry maintained with the Municipal Court in Prague under File No. C 211981, Company Id. No.: 018 20 877

Which personal data do we process? given name and surname, date of birth, address of permanent residence or other address, telephone number, e-mail address/addresses, birth number (S), passport/identity card number, marital status (S), sex, information concerning health status, in particular weight, height (S), biometric data - video recording from camera recording your body and movement in the sports areal, your signature (S), the above mentioned data concerning persons in relation to whom you exercise the parental responsibility, cookies.

“(S)” marks sensitive personal data.

For which purposes do we process your personal data?

- Provision of agreed services, i.e. usage of sports facilities.
- Protection and safety of your life, health and property.
- Protection and safety of life, health and property of other participants.
- Protection of property and legitimate interest of the Company.
- Marketing purposes.

What are the legal grounds for processing of your personal data?

- Rights arising from Article 6(1)(b),(d) and (f) of the GDPR.
- Your consent that you granted to us for purposes of processing of personal data (pursuant to Article 6(1) (a) of the GDPR).

Who is the recipient of your personal data? The Company.

What is the GDPR?

Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)

Are your personal data transferred to other entities?

- Your personal data may be transferred to subjects providing services in the areal operated by the Company (e.g. sports instructors).
- In connection with enforcement of our claims or in connection with our defense against claims against us your personal data may be transferred to our legal representatives, competent state and administrative authorities, courts, executors or other providers of legal services and services connect to debt collection.

In which form are your personal data processed?

In paper and electronic form.

How are your personal data protected against being misused?

All persons who come into contact with personal data have been properly trained and examined.
The archive of paper documents is secured against entry by unauthorized persons by locks and by other mechanical security measures.
Personal data processed in electronic form are stored in secured database.
In case of transfer of personal data to other person it is contractually required to secure your data against misuse by the recipient at the level required by the GDPR.

Are your personal data used for purposes of marketing?

- Yes, by our Company for purposes of offering appropriate offers. For this purposes we also perform your profiling so that our offers would suit your interests.
- Personal data are transferred for purposes of marketing also to other entities.
- We do not transfer or use your personal data for marketing purposes unless you grant us your consent to do so.

Are your personal data transferred abroad? No.

For how long will your personal data be processed?

- The personal data that we process on the basis of legal grounds stipulated in the GDPR are processed for time period necessary for provision agreed of services, for as long as necessary to prove the provision of services according to accounting and tax regulations and for as long as necessary for protection of our rights.
- The personal data processed on the basis of your consent will be processed for the period for which your consent has been granted.
- Video recording from camera recording your body and movement in the sports areal we store for 24 hours.

Are the sensitive personal data also being processed? Yes, in the above stated extent. The sensitive personal data are in many cases necessary for provision of services.

Is provision of your personal data necessary for entrance into your areal and for usage of sports facilities (trampolines)? Yes. Without provision of personal data you cannot enter the premises where are the sports facilities and you cannot use the sports facilities.

Which rights do you have with respect to the processing of personal data?

- Right to withdraw the consent.
- Right to access to your personal data.
- Right to rectification of your personal data.
- Right to demand erasure of your personal data.
- Right to demand restriction of processing of your personal data.
- Right to portability of your personal data.
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (The Office for Personal Data Protection) (in Czech: Úřad pro ochranu osobních údajů).
